This program is specifically designed to teach dental practitioners how to successfully approach multiple full arch implant cases. During this program, you will perform multiple **Full Arch/Full Mouth** dental implant cases and perform the step-by-step conversion of the full lower and upper denture into an immediate load, all under our faculty supervision. - Take open tray and closed tray impressions for the Full Arch prosthetic solution.
- Understand the bite registration.
- Understand Prostheses design.
- Understand the biomechanics for the Full Arch procedure.
- Understand the full arch dental implant occlusion.
- Know how to fabricate provisional and permanent prosthetic options.
- Know how to deal with possible full arch implant complications.
- Understand hygiene requirement and protocol for long-term success.
- Provide diagnosis, prognosis and properly sequenced comprehensive treatment plans.
- Perform comprehensive examinations, collect clinical data, and document the patient's dental and medical condition.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON THIS PROGRAM?

You will encounter various kinds of full arch cases and surgical procedures. All patients are preselected, screened, and evaluated in advance for each course participant.

Participants will be expected to treat at least 6 patients during the course. Participants who wish to gain experience in full arch restoration will have the opportunity to perform

the step-by-step conversion of the full upper and/or lower denture into an immediate load for 1-2 patients.

Every morning, on the days of live patient surgery, we have a short lecture and a meeting with all the doctors to evaluate and review the treatment plan and medical history for the patients that you will be treating that day. In that moment, with the X-Rays in hand, we evaluate the cases and discuss the best treatment plan and approach for each patient.

You will have the advantage of being trained by oral/maxillofacial surgeons and Implant Specialist.
