- Take open tray and closed tray impressions for the full arch prosthetic solution.
- Understand bite registration.
- Understand prostheses design.
- Understand the biomechanics for the Full Arch Prostheses.
- Understand the Full Arch prostheses occlusion.
- Know how to fabricate provisional and permanent prosthetic options.
- Know how to deal and solve possible dental implant prosthetic complications.
- Know the hygiene requirement and protocol for long-term success
