- Know how to deal with possible full arch implant complications.
- Understand hygiene requirement and protocol for long-term success.
- Provide diagnosis, prognosis and properly sequenced comprehensive treatment plans.
- Perform comprehensive examinations, collect clinical data, and document the patient's dental and medical condition.

The number and type of procedures you perform will depend on your skill level, surgical experience, the time required to successfully complete each procedure and your performance, as continually evaluated by the course instructors, during the course. Every morning, on the days of live patient surgery, we have a short lecture and a meeting with all the doctors to review the treatment plan and medical history for the patients that you will be treating that day.
